

Compared to the 36-Mpix [Nikon D800](#) models, the results are very similar indeed, implying the new [Sony A7R](#) uses the same (Sony made) sensor. The differences in individual metrics are close enough to be within our tolerances for testing, however, it may be also be down to the differences in the filters or the imaging chain in more general terms. In real world use, the variance in low-light scores is negligible. As for assessing image sharpness, we'll be adding lens tests with the Sony in the near future.
